3. Japanese Journal of Applied Physics SPECIAL ISSUE

Try to include new, original, and significant findings in your presentation for AM-FPD '10 and submit your manuscript using online submission no later than July 9, 2010. Note that your manuscript will be reviewed along the usual review process of the JJAP. Your paper should be an original research paper with well-developed discussions on the results obtained. The exactly same manuscript as your presentation in AM-FPD '09 cannot be accepted.
